Church Kitchen Remodel Update Corian dishes have been purchased to replace our old dishes. These are much lighter and take up less space than the old ones. The plumbing and electrical have been installed and either drywall or washable wall panels have been put up. The commercial hood has been put in the kitchen and also on the exterior of the church. The utility sink in the furnace room has been installed and a new floor has replaced the old one next to that sink. The grease trap has been installed and the water softener moved. Drywall in Fellowship Hall has been repaired. The kitchen walls and Fellowship Hall walls have been painted. Conduit for sound system microphones'

has been put in. Track lights in Fellowship Hall and the Kitchen hallway have been taken down and new LED lights will replace them. Insulation of the ceiling will be done by the time you read this, then the ceiling will be installed. Cabinets will be constructed, then the flooring and appliances will be installed.
