Worship at Peace Church

We have regathered at church with capacity limits of 25% of capacity (50 worshippers in the sanctuary, worship leaders are in addition to that number). We are not requiring sign-up for services. We have scheduled dates for us to worship in the Park again for May 23rd without attendance limits and with the ability to sing together. We will be discussing in the next few weeks how we will gather through the summer, at church or in the park, etc. Please watch for more information as we try to discern how to best serve as many needs and desires of the congregation as possible. This has been a year that has boldly reminded us that we will never make everyone happy, we are trying our best to listen and to be faithful.

We are continuing to require masks that cover the mouth and nose at all times, for people to practice social distancing, hand washing/sanitizing, and all those other mitigation measures to which we have all become accustomed.

We will continue streaming our worship services to YouTube (We record the 8:00am service and have it available any time after that). One of the blessings of the pandemic is that we will now continue offering services online forever and ever Amen.

We know that we are not yet out of the woods with the pandemic, and we would encourage everyone to please continue to act with care and caution. We have been trying to take all practical steps toward mitigation of the

pandemic as a Congregation -now is certainly not the time to stop trying to be a part of the solution. Get vaccinated when you are able- and remember you are not fully vaccinated until at least 2 weeks after your final shot! Do your part in thinking about how your choices impact all of our community. Our commitment is to continue seeking to love our neighbors as ourselves!
