Confessing and Receiving Forgiveness Yearning for mercy, we confess before our God:

> Risen Lord, you showed yourself to your disciples in so many ways, allaying their doubts and empowering their witness. We remember how the scales dropped from Saul's eyes allowing him to see the radical, challenging, newness of your gospel. We hear the story Lord, but we struggle against the proclamation that you also want to set us free. We confess that we are frightened of leaving our comfortable understandings of life and faith, for a world that you would show us. We confess that it is easier to fear than to trust in you.

> We confess our brokenness and long for your light. We sin against you in thought, word, and deed, by what we do, and by what we leave undone. We fail to recognize all of God's children as our neighbors and we fail to love them as you love us.

God of mercy, forgive us. Together we pray as you taught us (sins): "Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our sins, as we forgive those who sin against us. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen."

We gather in the love and promise of God's grace and mercy offered to each of us. Hear the good news: through Christ Jesus we are forgiven. Amen.
