
In the way of Jesus, we stand against acts of hate and violence in all their forms.



## Greetings - A Time of Centering





Being Gathered in the Presence of God – Psalm 139:1-12, 23-24

One: May the peace and grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all.

Many: And also with you.

Many: O LORD, you have searched me and you know me. You know when I sit and when I rise up; you perceive my thoughts from afar.

One: You discern my going out and my lying down; you are familiar with all my ways.

Many: Before a word is on my tongue you know it completely, O LORD. You hem me in—behind and before; you have laid your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

One:

One:

All:

Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
